

## Newington Food Bank

### Who is eligible?

The Newington Food Bank is available to Newington residents facing financial hardship, who fall under the 200% poverty guidelines. You must provide proof of current Newington residency, income and assets, and household members. To see if you meet the income guidelines, go to:

### How can I register?

You need to contact Carol LaBrecque at 665-8595 or Karen Futoma at 665-8596. An appointment will be scheduled to determine eligibility for the Food Bank and other financial assistance resources such as food stamps and energy assistance.

### Where is it located?

The Newington Food Bank is located in Town Hall.

### What kinds of items are available?

The majority of items are nonperishable food items. We do have some frozen and refrigerated items. We also have limited hygiene and household products.

### How much can I get?

The number of bags you are allowed is based on your household size. The food bank should be considered a supplement to your groceries. It will not meet your full monthly needs.

### How often can I use it?

Use is limited to once a month. Exceptions may be considered on an individual basis for extenuating circumstances.

### When is it open?

Tuesday afternoons: 12:00pm-3:00pm    The second and fourth Monday 4-6:45pm

Thursday mornings: 9:00am-12:00pm

## Food Share Truck At Market Square Parking Area

Every other week **11:30am-12:00pm**, eligible food bank patrons can attend an open air market in town, where fresh produce is also available. **Only registered** food bank recipients are allowed to access this market.
