

# Books-for-You



## Bringing the Library to Your Home!

Your library is as close as a phone call to the Lucy Robbins Welles Library's Books-for-You service. Books, magazines, audiobooks and more can be delivered directly to your doorstep.



If you are a Newington resident or a resident of a Newington healthcare facility and are either temporarily or permanently homebound you may qualify for our free Books-for-You program.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Who can use the Books-for-You service?

You are eligible for Books-for-You if you are homebound or unable to visit the library in person because of a temporary or permanent disability, recovery from surgery or an extended illness. Individuals requesting this service must have or be eligible for a valid library card from the Lucy Robbins Welles Library or be a resident of a Newington healthcare facility.

### How do I apply?

Use the application on the back of this brochure or call us at (860) 665-8700 to get an application. You may also print an application from the library's web site at [www.newingtonct.gov/library](http://www.newingtonct.gov/library) and mail it to the address on the form or fax to (860) 667-1255. After processing, we'll contact you to discuss your reading interests and help you make your selections. Then we'll deliver the materials to you.

### How does the service work?

Materials will be delivered to your home by a volunteer. Materials will be checked out on your Lucy Robbins Welles library card for 6 weeks. If you don't have a card, the library will issue you one. While you will be exempt from overdue fines, you will be responsible for the replacement cost of any lost or damaged materials.

### What can I borrow?

We will loan you any circulating book, book on cassette or cd, or magazine owned by Lucy Robbins Welles Library. You may make specific requests or we can choose titles for you based on your interests.
