Attendees may purchase their own copies of the books for discussion. The library will have a limited number of copies available for loan.

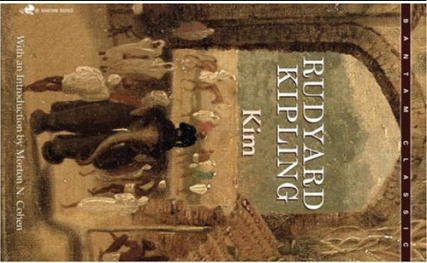
