PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN ,TEENS AND ADULTS - Interactive activities, learning opportunities and entertaining events for all ages.

FREE DOWNLOADABLE MEDIA - From our website to your device download and/or stream eBooks, audiobooks, eMagazines, digital music, and movies.

DVD's & BLU-RAYS - Popular and classic films for young and old, documentaries and instructional films.

ROKU & eReaders & Tablets - The library has circulating *Roku* devices to stream *Netflix* and circulating eReader devices preloaded with the latest bestselling fiction and non-fiction. **NEW**– Samsung Galaxy tablets can be checked out for 3 hours in the library to surf the internet, play games or read magazines.

MUSEUM PASSES - The library has free or reduced admission passes to more than 29 New England attractions.



FREE COMPUTER ACCESS & WIRELESS INTERNET - Free access to public internet access computers and wireless internet connections.

ELECTRONIC RESOURCES - Professional and popular journals, magazines and newspapers including *Consumer Reports Online*, *Chilton's Auto Repair* and *Morningstar*.

ONLINE LEARNING - Access to more than 540 free online classes and free online technology tutorials.

TEST PREPARATION - Study for the GED, SAT, GRE and more. Take practice tests online at home or in the library.

LEARN A FOREIGN LANGUAGE - *Transparent Language Online*, accessible through the library website, teaches pronunciation, vocabulary and conversational foreign languages, both basic and advanced levels.

EMPLOYMENT RESOURCES - Create a resume, search for jobs, complete online job applications, file for unemployment, explore educational opportunities.

BOOK DISCUSSIONS - Read a title selected by the group, then meet with others to share a conversation about the title.

BE CREATIVE - Come to the library for adult coloring, repurpose a book, make a new bracelet, compete in cupcake wars, or be a Jr. Lego maker. Use your imagination and collaborate at one of the many programs offered for children's, teens and adults.
