CHURCHILL PARK RULES

1. Tennis, basketball, volleyball and bocce courts, as well as the horseshoe pits, are for the intended sport only. Use of roller skates, skate boards, roller blades and bicycles on the courts are prohibited. Street hockey is also prohibited.
2. Players must wear tennis shoes or other non-marking athletic shoes on tennis courts.
3. Intentional throwing of rackets, balls, or other equipment is prohibited, as is intentional striking of the net or court surface.
4. Bleachers, benches, picnic tables, bases and pitching rubbers are not to be moved.
5. No motorized vehicles of any type shall be operated on lawns, fields or wooded areas unless specifically permitted by the Superintendent of Parks & Recreation.
6. Alcoholic beverages are permitted; however, kegs of beer, bottles and hard liquor are prohibited.
7. Dogs must be kept on leashes. All animals must be kept off the playing fields.
8. No golf allowed on ball fields.
9. The Town of Newington requests your cooperation in keeping the Parks & Recreation facilities a smoke-free environment.
10. The applicant or designee shall have a copy of the approved application present during approved use.
11. Inflatable structures, including bounce houses, slides, etc., are not allowed to operate on town property and are prohibited.
12. No sound systems without prior approval.
13. No banners, sandwich boards, or postings of any notices without prior approval of the Superintendent of Parks & Recreation.
14. Help us keep our parks clean by disposing of your trash in the receptacles provided.
