Residents may arrive at the park no earlier than 9:00 a.m. to permit servicing of restrooms and trash receptacles. No parking is allowed beyond the drive-up gate, within the picnic areas or near the basketball courts. Violators will be issued parking tickets by the Police Department. Vehicles must be returned immediately to the parking lot after unloading.

Inflatable structures, including slides and bounce houses are not allowed in any town parks.

In granting this permit, the town requests that the permittee follow all rules and regulations as adopted by the Parks & Recreation Department.
