Girls Grades 1 & 2 / Boys Grade 1

The basketball program for Girls Grades 1 & 2 and Boys Grade 1 will meet for one hour on Saturdays at Newington High School and will focus on skill development and instruction. There will be no weeknight practices. All registered participants will receive a T-shirt. The 8-week program will begin on January 5 and end on February 23. Lower baskets will be used.

Boys Grade 2

The basketball program for Boys in Grade 2 will meet for one hour on Saturdays with no weeknight practice. This program focuses on skill development and instruction. This year's program for Boys in Grade 2 has been slightly revised. At the start of the season (December 22 and 29), a Skills Clinic for all Boys Grade 2 coaches and players will be held at the Mortensen Community Center. Beginning on Saturday, January 5, the program will be held at Newington High School (unless otherwise noted). During the first 30 minutes, players will be participating in skills and drills led by their coaches. The last 30 minutes will be dedicated to fun, controlled scrimmages against other boys in Grade 2. Lower baskets will be used, and the program will end on February 23. All registered participants will receive a T-shirt.



Boys & Girls Grades 3 through 8

Both the Boys' and Girls' programs will stress skills, fundamentals and game play. This is an instructional, recreational league. There will be one evening of practice per week and one game on Saturdays. Practice nights are determined during the coaches orientation meeting in early December. We make every attempt to place all boys and girls on a team with other students from their respective schools. Unfortunately, we cannot honor specific requests by parents or players regarding team or coach preference. All registered participants will receive a T-shirt. The first team practice will be held on December 15 (details to follow). The basketball program will end at the beginning of March. Playoffs will be held for 5th through 8th grade teams and a jamboree will be held for 3rd & 4th grade teams. Lower baskets are used for Girls in Grades 3 & 4 and Boys in Grade 3.
