

NEWINGTON TAX PAYMENT NEWS

Approximately 44,000 tax bills will be mailed by the end of June. All tax bills are due July 1st with 30 days to pay. Your bill may be paid anytime during the month of July. The last day to pay without penalty is August 1st. By CT State Statute, any back taxes need to be paid first.

All businesses operating in Newington as of October 1, 2011 owe Personal Property taxes. Motor vehicle taxes are due in FULL, and the first installment on real estate, and personal property taxes. If you sold your home before July 1, 2012, you do not owe the real estate tax bill. Contact the Tax Office to notify them of the sale so the bill can be forwarded to the new owner.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS MAY BE MADE by calling 1-800-272-9829 or via internet at www.officialpayments.com. At the prompt, enter Jurisdiction Code 1732. There is a small fee for this service. Newington uses a club billing statement to help reduce costs. In the white middle section of your motor vehicle statement, under the Bill # column, there are seven numbers. Please add 2011-03 before the numbers when entering a bill number to the credit card company. These numbers are necessary to process the payments. For personal property and real estate taxes use the list numbers beginning with 2011 at the top of your bill. **Debit or Credit card payments are not accepted in the office.**

Any questions regarding assessments, or value should be made to the Assessor's Office at (860) 665-8530. Name and address changes need to be updated with the Tax Office at (860) 665-8540. Also contact the Motor Vehicle Department to change the address on each registration so future bills will be from your new town, and update your driver's license too.

A copy of your tax bill must be included with your payment. If you want a receipt, enclose the entire bill with your payment and a self-addressed envelope with a .45 cent stamp on it. One check may be made for your payments.
