

OFFICE OF ZONING ENFORCEMENT

GUIDE TO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN NEWINGTON

Section 3.22.2 Accessory Buildings and Uses permitted in all Residential Zones

3.22.2 C: A commercial vehicle not larger than one ton and customarily used by the resident for transportation is permitted for each dwelling unit. Such vehicle may be parked on a lot (in a driveway), but shall not be parked in the front yard or in the street right of way and must be owned by the resident.



Vehicle: Any device suitable for the conveyance, drawing or other transportation of persons or property, whether operated on wheels, runners, cushion of air between it and the surface of by any other means, except those propelled or drawn by human power, or those used exclusively on tracks.

Vehicle- Parked: A car which occupied the same space for less than 24 hours.

Vehicle- Stored: A car whether or not in operating condition, which occupies the same space, or space on the same lot or in the same building for more than 24 hours.
