Re: Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) - BOE Non-Lapsing Account

As a result of discussions between the Town and Board of Education, this item is proposed to increase the annual allocation for the current Fiscal Year only, ending June 30, 2020 by 0.79% or additional funds of \$590,355.00 for placement within the Board of Education Non-Lapsing Account.

Pursuant to C.G.S. 10-248a (Unexpended Education Funds Account), as amended by Public Act 19-117, for the fiscal year ending 2020 and each fiscal year thereafter, notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes or any special act, municipal charter, home rule ordinance, the Town Council, as the budget making authority, may deposit into a non-lapsing account any unexpended funds from the Board of Education's budget from the prior fiscal year. The amount placed into such account may not exceed two percent of the total budgeted appropriation for education for such prior fiscal year.

The Town Council was presented with this proposal during the May 12, 2020 Regular Meeting. A Resolution approving the single-year increase by 0.79% is included for your adoption.

Re: Appointment of Auditor

Pursuant to §610 of the Town Charter, the Town Council shall annually appoint an independent public accountant or firm to examine and certify the Town's financial records in accordance with statutory provisions. Connecticut General Statutes §7-396 and §4-232 provide that the appointing authority of any municipality must file with the State of the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) the name of the independent auditor designated to conduct its annual audit within at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of the fiscal year.

This year the Town issued a Request for Proposals for audit services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 and for three subsequent years. As a result of the RFP, the firm of Blum Shapiro was selected as the Town's independent auditor. The auditor must be re-appointed each year, this is the second year of the four-year agreement. This item appears on the May 12, 2020 agenda for discussion, with Council action to be taken at the May 19, 2020 meeting.

Re: Mill Pond Park Pool Project Building Committee

At the May 12, 2020 Regular Meeting the Town Council received a presentation on improvements to the Mill Pond Park Pool. Moving forward with this project will require the creation of a Public Building Committee, as required in the Newington Code of Ordinances, Chapter 8, Article X, Project Building Committees. It is therefore necessary to appoint a new project building committee to oversee the project and appoint an engineer/architect. The building committee may be appointed prior to an actual appropriation of said project.

The Council may determine the specific membership of the committee, exclusive of the exofficio members. The consensus of the Council for previous committees has been to establish a five-member committee with members representing the Town Council and Board of Parks & Recreation.

A draft resolution to determine membership and the scope of the project for the Mill Pond Park Pool Project Building Committee has been included for the Council's consideration. A final Resolution will be created for adoption at the next meeting of the Town Council.
