*Supported Devices:

iOS 15 + (Apple App Store)
Android 7.0 + (Google Play Store)
Bluetooth Speaker compatibility

Requirements:

- Must have a valid Newington library card
- Must have a device capable of connecting to the Internet
- Must have a device capable of downloading apps

Install The Palace Project on the device

1. Open the app store of the device
2. Search for Palace Project
3. Tap the result for **The Palace Project**
4. Tap the **Get** or **Install** button next to the search result for **The Palace Project**. If you see the *Open* button, the device already has The Palace Project installed



Setting up The Palace Project

1. Tap **Find Your Library**
2. Type or scroll until you find **Lucy Robbins Welles Library** and tap on the library name
3. This will bring you to **The Palace Project Catalog**

Searching

1. Tap **the magnifying glass** in the upper right corner
2. Type in what you are searching for



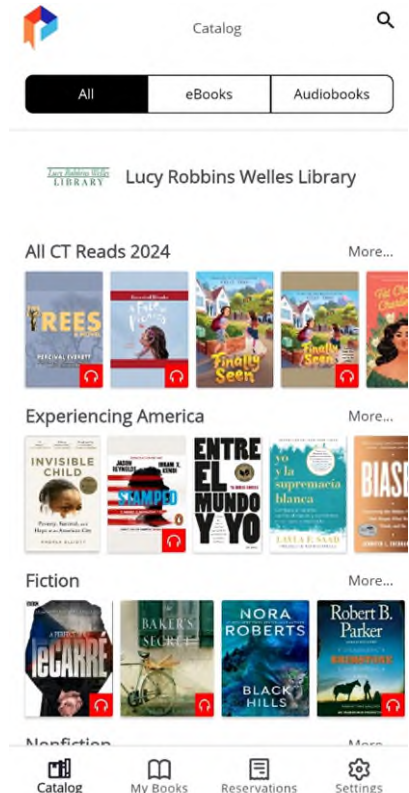
3. You can filter back and forth between audiobook and e-book selections

Browsing

1. You can browse between *All*, *eBooks*, and *Audiobooks*
2. Under **All**, **eBooks**, and **Audiobooks** are genres to choose from
3. Tap on **More...** under each genre to view a full list

Checkouts

1. Tap on the book you would like to check out
2. Tap **Get** or **Reserve**
3. If you get the option for **Reserve**, that item is not available at the moment and tapping reserve will place it on hold
4. Type in your library card number to **Get** or **Reserve** the item
