INFORMATION PARENTS AND STUDENTS NEED TO KNOW

1. All SCORE programs are open to students in grades 5 through 8 unless otherwise specified. Program registration is on a first come first serve basis. Human Services reserves the right to substitute, reschedule or cancel any program due to inclement weather. We will make every effort to contact parents/guardians and the schools to inform them of any changes.
2. Confirmation letters containing session location, pick-up and drop off sites, and other information will start being mailed to you by Friday, February 14th and continue on an ongoing basis. Only participants registered for the program are allowed to attend.
PLEASE KEEP CONFIRMATION LETTER HANDY FOR YOUR ONGOING REFERENCE.
3. ***TRANSPORTATION IS PROVIDED TO AND FROM ALL PROGRAM LOCATIONS. PARENTS WILL PICK-UP ALL PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS AT THE NEWINGTON CHALLENGE COURSE (281 Milk Lane). More information for the full day programs drop-off and pick-up locations will be attached to your confirmation letter.***
4. When participants are being picked up after school they should wait outside the front entrance of the school for a white, 15 passenger town van to arrive at their school after all the buses have left.
5. All participants must be picked up promptly at the end of a session. If a student is biking or walking home, it must be indicated on the registration form or in a note/email if a change occurs. Staff must be informed of any changes in dismissal arrangements or we cannot release your child.
6. **If your child cannot attend a SCORE session for any reason, it is your responsibility to inform Human Services staff prior to the end of the school day.** ANY UNEXCUSED absences (those without a prior phone call made by parent) will be reported to the parent/guardian.
7. Participants are expected to behave in a safe and responsible manner. Any disrespectful or disruptive behavior may result in dismissal from the program with no refund.

Hiking & Cook-out at Burr Pond State Park!*


