## PRESS RELEASE

On 11/06/2018, Newington Police served an active arrest warrant on Guillermo Serrano for the charges of Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, Arson 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, Criminal Mischief 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, and Reckless Endangerment 1<sup>st</sup> Degree. The warrant alleges that on 2/13/18, Serrano allegedly forced entry into a room at the Grantmoor Motor Lodge located at 3000 Berlin Turnpike, and intentionally started a fire while guests occupied other rooms in the motel.

A Detective from the Hartford Police Fugitive Task Force identified Serrano sitting in the passenger seat of a vehicle in Hartford. After a short foot pursuit, Serrano was taken into custody and turned over to the Newington Police Department.

Serrano was detained on a \$1,000,000.00 bond and appeared in New Britain Superior Court on 11/07/18.
