GENERAL PERMIT NUMBER 1

Issued To: The Town of Newington
Date: March 16, 2021
Length of Permit: 5 Years
Permit Expires: March 16, 2026

The Town of Newington is hereby re-issued, as of March 16, 2021 a GENERAL PERMIT for the purpose of removing accumulated material from watercourses, minor pipe installations, minor grading operations, minor construction activity and other maintenance related activities.

Under this GENERAL PERMIT, the Town is authorized to perform maintenance activities as follows; watercourses, wetlands and upland review areas (URA) to be cleaned, and other maintenance activities to be conducted which may include; removing accumulated material from watercourses, minor pipe installations, minor grading operation, minor construction activity and other maintenance related activities. The Department Head of the various Town departments working in the regulated area shall notify the Administrative Officer (Wetland Agent) in writing in advance of the proposed activity as to the scope, timeline, means and methods of the intended activity to be done under this General Permit. The Administrative Officer shall in turn notify the Commission and/or the Chairman of these activities.

This GENERAL PERMIT is effective as of the date stated above and shall be valid for five (5) years. The Commission reserves the right to require a formal permit application if it determines the proposed activity not to be minor or maintenance in nature.
