Pass Use Guidelines



Many museums now participate in our Print-on-Demand program. Print-on-Demand means that you are able to print out the museum pass from home or a local printer. These passes do not need to be returned.

How do I get a pass?

You may reserve a pass using our webpage from home or you may call the library at 860-665-8700 to reserve a pass. If it is a Print-on-Demand pass, just print and go. A library staff member will also be happy to reserve a pass for you. You may reserve passes up to 90 days in advance. **Reservations must be made with an Adult Library Card.**

When can I pick up my physical pass?

Your physical pass should be available after 1 p.m. on the day before your reservation. Because we cannot control when the pass is actually returned, we advise you to please call 860-665-8720 to determine if your pass is available. **Your pass must be checked out from the library with the same library card that was used to make the reservation. Reservations must be made with an Adult Library Card.**

Are there any limits or penalties?

You may reserve 4 passes per month but you may not exceed 1 reservation per family per month for the same museum. If you fail to pick up passes twice in a 90 day period you will be blocked from reserving passes for 90 days. There is a \$5.00 per day late fine and a replacement fee for a lost pass.

When does the physical pass need to be returned?

The pass is checked out until noon the day after your visit to the museum. Passes should be returned to the circulation desk. The book drop may be used when the library is closed.

May I borrow a pass on a day that the library is closed?


Yes, if you wish to visit a museum on a day that the library is closed, you may pick up the physical pass on the day prior to the library's closed day(s). Print-on-Demand passes may be printed at any time.

How do I cancel a reservation?

If you reserve a pass and change your plans, you may cancel your own reservation on the Museum Passes page on our website. Printed passes would then be invalid.

You may reserve by museum, or you may reserve by date. Reservations must be made with an Adult Library Card.

By museum: Click on **view available passes by museum** and then click on the museum graphic of the place you'd like to visit. Available reservation dates will be displayed. Click on the date you'd like to visit. Enter your library card number and PIN, then click *Reserve Pass* button. Print the pass now if it is a Print-on-Demand.

By date: Click on **view available passes by date**. Click on the date you'd like to reserve a pass. All available museums will be displayed. Click on the name of the place you'd like to visit. Enter your library card number and PIN, then click *Reserve Pass* button. You may print the pass now if it is a Print-on-Demand.
