Important Things to Know Before Registering...

If registering as a team, please have team rosters set prior to registration. Team rosters must have a **minimum of 8 registered players**. Teams without at least 8 registered players on their rosters may be split up. **MAXIMUM of 12 Teams.**

Individuals without a team may sign up and will be placed on a team by the Parks & Recreation Staff.

Games are played on Friday nights or Saturday mornings at the Mortensen Community Center Gymnasium.

Divisions will be determined prior to the start of the season. Please indicate on your registration form what division you feel you should be placed in. Final decisions will be made by the Parks & Recreation Staff.

Rules & Information

- **Divisions:** The league will consist of an Upper & Lower division - games are played on Friday nights or Saturday mornings.
- **Teams:** Maximum of 12 teams allowed in the League.
- **Regular Season:** Divisions to be determined after 12/20 & 12/21 divisioning games. Scrimmages will be played on 12/27 & 12/28. League starts 1/3 & 1/4/20.
- **Playoffs:** Playoffs will be single elimination format.
- **Grace Period:** A grace period of 5 minutes is allowed for the first game; grace periods will not apply to any other games.
- **Uniforms:** All players will be issued a numbered shirt in their team color. Players must wear their shirt during all games; switching of shirts among teammates is not permitted. If teams have similar colors, a coin toss will determine which team must wear pinnies when playing each other.
- **Players:** Teams will be allowed to start play with a minimum of 4 players. A 5th player may enter the game during any normal stoppage of play. Only players & coaches on the official roster of the teams competing may sit on the side of the gym closest to the scorer's table. All other spectators **MUST** sit on the bleachers on the opposite side of the gym.
- **Rosters:** 8-player minimum roster; 10-player maximum. A player cannot switch rosters or be on more than one roster.
- **Eligibility:** All players must be residents of Newington in grades 9 through 12 or attend Newington High School.
- **Game Time:** Games will be 40 minutes in length (two 20-minute halves). Games will be running time, except for the following: Clock will stop on all whistles during the last minute of the first half. Clock will stop on all whistles during the last 2 minutes of the second half. Clock will stop on all whistles during the last minute of overtime.
- **Substitutions:** Subs must check in at scorer's table prior to entering game.
- **Time Outs:** Each team is granted 2 time outs per half (time outs cannot be carried over to second half).
- **Overtime:** In the event of a tie,
 - One additional 3-minute time out will be given to each team.
 - Any unused second half time outs may be applied to the overtime period.
 - If tied after the first overtime, the game is over (unless during playoffs).
 - During playoffs, additional overtime periods will be played until a winner is determined.
- **Fouls:** The fifth foul committed in a game by an individual player will result in removal from the remainder of the game.
- **Foul Shots:** Players may enter the lane upon release of the ball by the shooter.
- **Technical Fouls (applies to players and coaches):**
 - 1st Technical Foul in a game – Removed from the game and may not participate for the remainder of the game.
 - 2nd Technical Foul in a game – Removed for the remainder of that game and will not be allowed to participate in the team's next game.
 - 3rd Technical Foul in a season - Anyone receiving 3 technical fouls during the season (including playoffs) will be suspended & will not be allowed to participate in any remaining games during the season, including playoffs. Suspended players or coaches may sit in the stands on the opposite side of the court but are not allowed to sit on the bench. If a suspended player or coach causes a disruption from the stands, he or she will be asked to leave the gym.
- **Ejection:** Anyone who has been ejected from a game must leave the gym immediately and will not be allowed to participate in the team's next game. Anyone who has been ejected for a second time during the season will not be allowed to participate for the remainder of the season (including playoffs).
- **Coaches:** Each team is allowed one non-playing coach. All coaches must sign and comply with Coach Code of Ethics. Coaches receiving technical fouls or ejections will follow the same rules as outlined above.

Rules may be revised during the season at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation Dept—any rule changes will be posted.

All conflicts (including rule interpretations) will be resolved by Parks & Recreation staff, and their decision is final!

Players' or coaches' conduct or complaints from officials or scorer's table may lead to game or league suspension. The Parks & Recreation Department has the final decision in enforcing all rules.

Team Eligibility Requirements

In order for your team to be eligible to play during the 2020 season, the following information must be submitted by Friday, December 13:

- ⇒ Completed roster (8-player minimum; 10-player maximum)
- ⇒ Program Registration Form from each member of your team (must be signed by a parent or guardian if you are under the age of 18)
- ⇒ Photocopy of Newington High School ID or proof of Newington residency (all players must be residents of Newington in grades 9 through 12 or attend Newington High School)
- ⇒ Signed Player Code of Ethics by all players
- ⇒ Signed Coach Code of Ethics by coach (each team is permitted one non-playing coach)
- ⇒ Participation Fee: \$105.00 per player
- ⇒ **One designated Team Captain** who will handle all communication with Parks & Recreation staff.

Coaches



Each team may have one non-playing coach. The coach must complete the registration form but does not need to pay the registration fee. A coach may not substitute for a player as they are not eligible to play. A coach may only coach one team in the league and is subject to all league rules. If a coach's behavior is deemed inappropriate by the staff, the coach may be asked to leave the gym. All coaches must sign the Coach Code of Ethics.
